CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RAY McLAUGHLIN

of Rt. 2, Box 41, Woodburn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River, a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16298 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.237 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on G. G. Townsend D.L.C. Section 21, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 5.7 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on G. G. Townsend D. L. C.
- 6.7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on G. G. Townsend D. L. C. Section 21
- 3.7 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on G. G. Townsend D. L. C.
- 2.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on G. G. Townsend D. L. C. Section 28

T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of the G. G. Townsend D. L. C. in Township 5 South Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County Oregon, said point being 17.75 chains Northerly from the South West corner of said claim; thence East 35.21 chains to the county road; thence North along said road, 2.26 chains; thence East along said county road, 4.00 chains to an angle in said road; thence North along said road 5.5 chains to the North East corner of land conveyed by Minnie Ballweber to George Ballweber and Bertha Ballweber, which deed is recorded in Vol. 143, Page 251 of the Deed Records in and for Marion County, Oregon; thence West along the North line of said tract of land 40.00 chains to the Northwest corner thereof; thence South along the West line of said tract, 7.75 chains to the place of beginning, and containing thirty (30) acres of land, more or less, all lying and being in Marion County Oregon. SAVE AND EXCEPT THEREFROM that part thereof conveyed by Ben Singer on the 30th day of April, 1936.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
