This Is to Certify, That JOHN ZEHNER

of Route 1, Jefferson State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River and Keesneck Lake

a tributary of Willamette River

Permit A-1-500-1-4

irrigation under Permit No. 16480

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 25, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.20 cubic feet per second, being 0.625 cubic foot per second from Willamette River and 0.575 cubic foot per second from Keesneck Lake,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW_4^2 SW_4^1 from Willamette River and SW_4^2 SE_4^2 from Keesneck Lake, as projected on Wm. H. Helm D.L.C. No. 56. Section 13, Township 9 South, Range L West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same unds, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second right existing for the same unds, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres in the NE $_4^1$ SW $_4^1$, as projected on Vm. H. Helm D.L.C. No. 56 17.3 acres in the SV $_4^1$ SW $_4^1$, as projected on Vm. H. Helm D.L.C. No. 56 38.8 acres in the SE $_4^1$ SV $_4^1$, as projected on Vm. H. Helm D.L.C. No. 56 7.2 acres in the SV $_4^1$ SV $_4^1$, as projected on Vm. H. Helm D.L.C. No. 56
