**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** WILLIAM L. AND THELMA H. HANSEN

of Scottsburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including irrigation of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre lawns or gardens, under Permit No. 16568 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 4, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 9 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 8  
T. 22 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the line between Sections 7 and 8, Township 22 South, Range 9 West of the Willamette Meridian and the northerly boundary of the Samuel Rich DLC No. 38; thence East along said Northerly boundary approximately 788 feet to the Westerly line of the land deeded to J. C. Scott by Fred C. Schimmel and wife, which line is 333 feet West of and parallel with the Westerly line of Ed Spicer D.L.C. No. 39; thence North about 287.6 feet to the Southerly boundary of the right of way of Oregon Highway No. 38; thence along the Southerly boundary of said highway to its intersection with the Westerly boundary of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 9 West of the Willamette Meridian; Thence South 39.5 feet to the point of beginning, all being in Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 9 West of the Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, and containing 3.9 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
