CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That O. L. PACE

of Enterprise, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Prarie Creek and Clear Creek a tributary of Wallowa River and Hurricane Creek for the purpose of irrigation, under Permit No. 16610 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 27, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.262 cubic foot per second, being 0.115 cubic foot per second from Prarie Creek and 0.147 cubic foot per second from Clear Creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from Prarie Creek and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30-day period from May 1st to July 31st, and thereafter shall be limited to one acre foot per acre for the remainder of the irrigation season ending October 1; and from Clear Creek this appropriation shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30-day period from May 1st to July 31st and thereafter shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the remainder of the irrigation season. The amount of water shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State official, and shall

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: A portion of Lots 1, 2 and 3, and the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter, and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, of Section 3, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, of the Willamette Meridian, Wallowa County, Oregon, more particularly described as:

Beginning at a point on the north line of said Section 3 which bears north 89° 2' West 1080.3 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section for a place of beginning, and running thence North 89° 2' West 1456 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 2, of said Section, thence South 64.4 feet, thence south 69° 19' West 281.7 feet, thence South 85° 6' West 403.2 feet, thence South 75° 36' West 601 feet to a point on the west line of Lot 3, of said section which bears South 2° 42' East 925.6 feet from the Northwest corner of said Lot 3, thence South 2° 42' East and along the West line of said Lot 3, 259.1 feet thence south 76° East 247.5 feet; thence South 59° 45' East 169 feet; thence South 43° 30' East 238.9 feet; thence South 51° 30' West 132 feet; thence South 44° East 50 feet; thence North 51° 30' East 132 feet; thence North 54° 36' East 147.8 feet; thence South 66° 15' East 310.9 feet; thence South 66° 45' East 337.3 feet; thence South 50° 15' East 184.8 feet; thence North 86° 30' East 116.8 feet; thence South 22° 30' East 244.9 feet; thence South 26° 15' west 660 feet to a point on the north line of the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company right-of-way; thence southeasterly along the north line of said right-of-way to a point on the west line of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter, of said Section 3, thence north along said west line of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter, of said Section 3, 1180 feet, more or less to the Southwest corner of Lot 1, of said Section 3, thence east

along the South line of said Lot 1, of said Section 3, 138 feet; thence north 1730.5 feet to the point of beginning, EXCEPTING, however, from the premises above described those portions thereof heretofore conveyed to Forsythe and Hass by deeds dated March 7, 1905 and July 11, 1910, and recorded in Book M, page 163, and Book E, page 569, respectively, of the Dead Records of Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
