CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. H. DAY,

of R.F.D. #1, Milton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of waste water from Rueberg and Ross properties a tributary of S. Fork Walla Walla for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 16794 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 5 North, Range 36 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water, provided that water is to be diverted for use only after it has passed off the Rueberg and Ross properties.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 22
T. 5 N., R. 36 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: All of that portion of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the W $\frac{1}{3}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22 in T. 5 N., R. 36 E., W.M., lying north of the bluff on the south side of the Walla Walla River, containing about 6 acres, more or less; ALSO: a tract of land 127 yards wide along the east line of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, T. 5 N., R. 36 E., W.M.; Umatilla County, Oregon, extending from the north line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 22 south and across the main channel of the Walla Walla River and to the foot of the bluff on the south side of the Walla Walla River in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, in said township and range.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
