**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** B. BREITHAUPT

of Route 2, Aurora, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River a tributary of --- for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17104 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 17, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.063 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Jos. LaForte D.L.C. No. 39, Section 32, Township 3 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Jos. LaForte D.L.C. No. 39  
2.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Jos. LaForte D.L.C. No. 39

T. 3 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Lots No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8, in Block 1, in the Town of Butteville, Marion County, Oregon, as shown by the Plat of said Town of Butteville, of record at Page 6, of Vol. 1, of Records of Town Plats for said County of Marion, State of Oregon; Also a fractional lot as shown by the recorded Town Plat of St. Alexcie at Page 37 of Vol. 1, of Town Plats Records for said Marion County; bounded on the Southerly side by the Northerly line of Union Street; on the Westerly side by the Willamette River, and on the Northerly side by Block 1, of said Town of Butteville. Said fraction of land, according to the plats and surveys is a direct Westerly extension of Lot 1, Block 1 in said Town of Butteville.

Also Beginning on the Westerly side of Main Street, at the most Easterly corner of Block 1 of said Town of Butteville, Marion County Oregon; Thence North 55° West, Along the Northerly line of said Block 1, which is the Southerly line of Lane Street to the meander line of the right bank of the Willamette River; Thence Northeasterly along said meander line of the Willamette River to and along the westerly line of Blocks 5 and 6 of said Town of Butteville and continuing thereon along said meander line to the most Westerly corner of the tract of land conveyed to the Butteville Farmers Warehouse Association by deed recorded July 6, 1891, in Vol. 42, Page 260, Marion County Deed Records; Thence North 65° 30" East along the Southerly line of said tract 255 feet more or less, to said Westerly line of Main Street, also known as the County Road; Thence South 35° West a long said Westerly line about 834.18 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
