CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FELIX SCHULTZ

of Route 2, Silverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek and Pudding River a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 17119 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 27, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second, being 0.253 cubic foot per second from Abiqua Creek and 0.057 cubic foot per second from Pudding River,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on David Newsom D.L.C. No. 55 and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on David Newsom D.L.C. No. 55
12.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the So. line of the John J. Tucker DLC which is 4.76 chains east of the SW corner of said claim in T 6 S R 1 W of the Will. Meridian in Mar. Co., Ore. and running thence So. 73 degrees W. to the center of Pudding River; thence up the center of the Pud. Riv. to the center of the mouth of Abiqua Creek; thence up the center of Abiqua Creek to the west line of Jennings Smith land; thence north 11.80 chains to the So. line of the DLC of John J. Tucker; thence west 19.43 chains along the south line of said J. J. Tuckers Claim to the place of beginning, and containing 56.60 acres of land more or less all in Marion Co., St. of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
