## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROY C. BAKER

of 705 First Street, Newberg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Chehalem Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 17182 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 1, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.007 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$   $NW\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on John H. Hess, D.L.C. No. 39, Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed,  $\epsilon$  and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on John H. dess D.L.C. No. 39 Section 19

T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the preserty more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Situate, lying and lang in Yamhill County, Oregon, and being a part of Tracts 19 and 50 of Hurley's Fruit Land Subdivision of a part of John H. Hess D.L.C. No. 39, in Township 3 South of Range 2 West, and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of said tract which is also the Southwest corner of Tract 20 of said Subdivision and running thence West 50 feet, thence North to the center of the Creek; thence Northeasterly along the center of said creek to the Northeast corner of said tract, which is also the Northwest corner of Tract No. 20; thence South along the West line of said Tract No. 20 to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
