CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLARENCE ESTENSON

of Box 733, Mill City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of North Santiam River for the purpose of domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 17481 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 23, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 9 South, Range 3 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 30

T. 9 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: The west one-half of a tract described as beginning at a point which is 12.50 chains South of the N. E. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty (30) in Twp. 9, S. R. 3 E. of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; Thence running North 21.75 chains; thence West 5.50 chains; thence South 20.54 chains; thence East 2.05 chains; thence S. 69 deg's 10' East 3.395 chains to an iron pipe; thence East 0.275 chains to the point of beginning and containing 11.52 acres, more or less, all in Marion County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
