CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLARENCE HOSER

of Route 1, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek

a tributary of Pudding River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17554 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 17, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each a cre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.7 acres in the NW1 SW1 2.4 acres in the SW1 NW1 1.2 acres in the SW1 SW1 Section 19
T. 6 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning on the Willamette Meridian 11.65 chains North of the corner of Sections 19 and 30, 24 and 25, in Township 6 South, Range 1 East and One West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, State of Oregon; thence South 54° 13' East 2.65 chains to a stake on the edge of the high bank of the Abiqua Creek from which stake a red fir tree three feet in diameter bears North 47° East 11 links; thence North 8° 30' East 48.15 chains to a stake in the County Road leading to Gervais; thence North 71° 45' West in said road 8.58 chains to the Northeast corner of a 46.15 acre tract sold and conveyed by Ezra C. Wyatt and wife to Joseph R. Hall by deed recorded December 17, 1892, in Volume 50 on page 591 deed records for Marion County, Oregon; thence South 8° 30' West on the East line of said tract 43.84 chains, more or less to the Southeast corner of said tract; thence North 86° East 4.50 chains; thence South 19° East 5.50 chains to the place of beginning, and containing 40½ acres, more or less.

SAVE and EXCEPT therefrom that portion thereof described in deed from Karl Sprauer and Anna Sprauer, his wife, to John Peter Weisenfels and Lena Weisenfels, his wife,

recorded November 7, 1941, in Volume 265, on page 238, deed records for Marion County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
