a tributary of Abernathy Creek irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 14513 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 30, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.019 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the 1.44 + 0

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre. Of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.5 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34

T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section Thirty-four (34); running thence South 20 chains to the 1/16 section corner; thence South 70° West along the center line of the County Road 5.48 chains; thence North 18.67 chains; thence North 58° 12' East 6.06 chains to the place of beginning, containing ten (10) acres, more or less, all in Section thirty-four (34) Township Two (2) South Range Two (2) East of the Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
