of Summit , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Marys River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 14683 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.203 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

West, point of diversion is located in the NEA NEA, Section 17, Township II South, Range 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second a Perfection of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is is follows:

0.3 acre in the SW1 SE1 6.0 acres in the SE1 Section 8
14.4 acres in the NE1 NE1 NE1 0.3 acre in the NW1 NE1 Section 17
T. 11 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
