## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That STATE OF OREGON, STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

of Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Galloway Creek, tributary of Bowers Slough, to be appropriated under Application No. 16744, Permit No. 12526,

for the purposes of storage for irrigation of forest nursery

under Reservoir Permit No. R-704 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 13, 1937

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 8.0 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 36, Tp. 10 S., R. 5 W., W.M.
