## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That **MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST,**  
**901 Terminal Sales Bldg.** **U. S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE**  
of Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Branch of Still Creek  
a tributary of Zigzag River for the purpose of  
domestic supplies for Summit Guard Station  
under Permit No. 15216 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon: that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from January 27, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.05 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13, Township 3 South, Range 8 $\frac{1}{2}$   
East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 24  
T. 3 S., R. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
