that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. diversion is located in the SWA NWA, Section 24, Township 6 South, Range 1 The point of diversion is located in the West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to per acre, of 100 squitation of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
