CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLINTON UFFORD

of Lacombe, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Beaver Creek a tributary of South Santiam River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15339 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 23, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.038 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in use of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 11 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 31

T. 11 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point in center of Beaver Creek where it crosses center Sec. line of Sec. 31, T. 11 S., R. 1 E., W.M. between the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$. Thence N. along said center Sec. line 569 ft. to a point between SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$. Thence due E. 39 $\frac{1}{4}$ ft. thence South 156 ft. to center sec. line between NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$. Thence E. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. to center of N. fork of Beaver Creek thence along center of creek to point of beginning containing about 2 acres.

Beginning at a point in center of creek at the forks of the main creek about 100 ft. E. from the first point of beginning. Thence follow up N. bank of South fork of Beaver Creek, 150 ft. Thence in a N. E. direction parallel to N. fork and circling to a point 426 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. E. from the center Sec. post. Thence along S. bank of N. fork to point of beginning containing about 2 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
