CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN R. SAXTON

of Route 2, Corvallis . State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Beaver Greek for the purpose of a tributary of Muddy Creek, a tributary of Marys River irrigation under Permit No. 16035 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 24, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.195 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SET SET, as projected on Stephen Gates D.L.C. No. 50,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.8 acres in the SE_4^1 SE_4^1 , as projected on Stephen Gates D.L.C. No. 50 Section 10

7.4 acres in the NE4 NE4, as projected on Stephen Gates D.L.C. No. 50 4.4 acres in the SEI NEI, as projected on Stephen Gates D.L.C. No. 50 Section 15

Mer., in Benton County, Oregon, and running thence S. 89° 41' W. 9.291 chains to a stone the SE corner of Andrew Jasper Claim #49, thence N. 34' W. on the East line of Claim 49, 13.442 chains to a 3/4" pipe, thence N. 89° 47' W. 9.897 chains to a stone, thence N. 0° 23' W. 11.287 chains to a stone, thence N. 89° 26' E. 9.859 chains to a 3/4" pipe on the east line of said Claim #49, thence N. 0° 34' W. 1.798 chains to an iron bar, the N.E. O. 06' E. 26.88 chains to the place of beginning, containing 143.16 acres, more or less, in Benton County, Oregon; Also, a private road, over other lands formerly owned by the grantors as shown in deed recorded in Book 64 at Page 268, Deed Records of Benton County, Oregon; also, the D.L.C. of Stephen Gates and Elizabeth Gates, his wife, Claim #50, being parts of Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15 in Tp. 13 S.
