of Portland to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Fork Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 16185 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 1, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE1 SW1, as projected on John Lehmhart D.L.C. No. 52, Section 14, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper st. te officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre in the SE_4^1 NW_4^1 , as projected on John Lehnhart D.L.C. No. 52 12.8 acres in the NE 3 SW4, as projected on John Lehnhart D.L.C. No. 52 Section 14

T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the North Bank of the South Umpqua River, said point being the Southwest corner of the tract of land conveyed by John Jones and Jacob Jones to Richard Bauer and Henry Schroten the deed for which is recorded in Volume 20 on pages 321 and 322, Records of Douglas County, thence North 1° East on the West side of said tract of land 11.22 chains to the Northwest corner of said tract of land; thence on the North line of said tract of land North 89° 30' East 8.78 chains; thence South 1° West to the South Umpqua River; thence following the North Bank of said South Umpqua River down stream to the place of beginning, containing 13.45 acres more or less, all in Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.E. Also a tract or parcel of land for a roadway 20 feet wide and 130 feet long the same being described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point which point is the Northeast corner of the above described lands thence North 89° 30' East on the North boundary line of the land owned by R. F. Moznetts 130 feet; thence South 20 feet; thence South 89° 30' West 130 feet to the East boundary line of the above described land; thence North 1° East on the East boundary line of the above described lands 20 feet to the place of beginning, containing .06 acres, more or less, in T. 27 S R. 6 W. W.M. in Douglas County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
