CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES L. AND EVA M. STEELE

of Alsea, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Alsea River for the purpose of domestic use for one family under Permit No. 16625 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 8, 1945

; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Gov. Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 6, Township 14 South, Range 9 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in Gov. Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 6
T. 14 S., R. 9 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: A tract of land averaging about 400 feet in width east of and adjoining the Alsea River bounded on the north by the north line of Govt. Lot 3, said Section 6 and extending south westerly 1000 feet.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
