## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

## This Is to Certify, That D. B. AND HARY C. APPLING

of Route 2, Springfield , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lost Creek

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16915 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 2, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_2^1$   $NW_2^1$ , as projected on William McCall D.L.C. No. 39, Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre in the SW NW a, as projected on William McCall D.L.C. No. 39 12.0 acres in the SE NW a, as projected on William McCall D.L.C. No. 39 Section 8

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: All of that portion of the William McCall Donation Land Claim No. 39, Notf. No. 6517 in Township 19 South Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Lane County, Oregon lying east of the center of the County Road now know as the Willamette Highway down to its crossing of Lost Creek and east of said Lost Creek northerly from said crossing point and also lying north of the center of that road which is described in that certain Deed and Agreement executed by Frances Holman and husband, Dalton Guiley and wife, Vina Carter and husband, Myrtle Castelman and husband, Vera Mathews and husband Clara Miller and husband, John Olsen and wife, Frank Wiebke and wife and recorded on page 52 and 53, volume 1h2 of Deed Records of Lane County, Oregon as the said road has been and now is actually located across said premises excepting therefrom about 2 acres from the north end thereof and partially described in that deed recorded on page 169 of volume G, Deed Records of Lane County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
