CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED H. POLCHOW

Route 6, Box 120 F.,
of Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Fanno Creek a tributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 17097 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 7. 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.022 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE_4^1 NE_4^1 , Section 13, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 0.022 cubic feet per second,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres in the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄
Section 13
T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. H.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point formed by the intersection of the Oleson Road and the S side line of the Bertha-Beaverton (Hillsboro Highway) highway running thence South 11 degrees 53 minutes east along the center of said Oleson Road 965 feet to a point, thence E 30 feet to the true point of beginning of the property line being described; thence North 11 degrees 53 minutes W. 213.1 feet to a point which is the SW corner of a tract formerly owned by Wallis; thence Easterly along the S. line of said tract formerly owned by Wallis 26h' to a point, being the SE corner of the former Wallis tract, thence northerly 209 feet to a point being the NE corner of the former Wallis tract thence easterly 209 feet, thence southerly parallel to the Willamette Meridian 418 feet to a point, thence Westerly 428 feet more or less to the point of beginning. Containing approximately 3.3 acres more or less being the tracts #15, #16, and #17 of the unofficial and unrecorded plot of Patton acres tracts as they appears attached to and made a part of the last Will and Testament of Mary E. Patton, deceased filed in the probate court records of Washington County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
