## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That E. L. McCAULEY

of 2838 Dover, Longview , State of Washington , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Gribble Creek a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 17124 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 1. 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot  $5 (SW_4^1 SW_4^1)$ , Section 16, Township 4 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 acres in the SW1 SW1, as projected on John Marks D.L.C. No. 37

1.4 % res in Lot 5 (SW4 SW4)

Section 16

4.4 acres in the SEA SEA, as projected on John Marks D.L.C. No. 37 Section 17

4.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on John Marks D.L.C. No. 37 Section 20

0.2 acre in the  $NW_1^1$   $NW_2^1$ , as projected on John Marks D.L.C. No. 37 Section 21

T. 4 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Donation Land Claim of John Marks; Running thence south 16.08 chains; thence west 24.87 chains; thence N. 16.08 chains; thence east 9.47 chains; thence N. 18.94 chains; thence east to claim line; thence southeasterly along claim line 19.70 chains to the place of beginning containing 64 acres, more or less, also Lot No. 5, Section 16, Township 4 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, in said County and State.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
