CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

AMOS AND OSTE MISHLER

of Route 1, Brownsville , State of Onegon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 17233 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 14. 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.135 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE¼ NE¾ and SE¼ NE¾, as projected on Wm. P. Templeton D.L.C. No. 46, Section 4, Township 14 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acre in Lot 1 ($NW_{\frac{1}{4}}NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$)

0.6 acre in the SW NW , as projected on Wm. P. Templeton D. L. C. No. 46

7.5 acres in Lot 2 (NE NE 1)

1.9 acres in the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, as projected on Wm. P. Templeton D. L. C. No. 46

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 59 rods and 9 feet East of the Northwest corner of the D.L.C. of William T. Templeton and wife, Not. No. 2619, Claim No. 46 in Township 14 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Linn County, Oregon; and running thence East 20.12 chains; thence South 15.50 chains; thence West 20.12 chains; thence North 15.50 chains to the place of beginning, containing 31.20 acres, more or less, all in Linn County, Oregon,

Also, Beginning on the right bank of the Calapoola River on the South boundary line of the D.L.C. of William Alford and wife, in Township 1h South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridiam, Oregon, and at a point 53.63 chains West of the Southeast corner of said D.L.C., and running from thence East 33.70 chains; thence South 1h.69 chains to the North line of the D.L.C. of William T. Templeton and wife in said Township and Range; thence West along the North boundary line of said D.L.C. of said William T. Templeton, 25.50 chains to the right bank of said Calapoola River; thence Northwesterly along the right bank of said Calapoola River to the place of beginning, and containing h0.00 acres, in Linn County, Oregon, and being a part of the D.L.C. of Andrew J. Warren and wife, Not. No. 7973 in said Township and Range.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
