CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN C. LAMB AND/OR CATHARINE LAMB

of Kernville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Anderson Creek a tributary of Siletz River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, under Permit No. 17261 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 30, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 8 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 17
T. 8 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point that is 500 feet North and 114 feet northwesterly along the Siletz River Highway from the Southeast corner of Lot 1 section seventeen township eight, south of range ten west of Willamette Meridian, running northwesterly along said highway 100 feet, thence south 510 feet more or less to the Siletz River, thence following the said Siletz River southeasterly 100 feet, more or less to a point that is south of the true point of beginning of this tract, thence north 510 feet, more or less to the place of beginning, situated in Section 17, Township 8 South, Range 10 West of Willamette Meridian, in Lincoln County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
