CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ARTHUR E. FRY

of Rt. 6, Box 1264 E, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fanno Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17405 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 23, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 667 feet west and 209 feet north of the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 13, Township 1 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian: thence running west 294 feet to center of County Road, known as the Olson Road; thence north 11° 53' West following the center line of said road, 213.1 feet to a point; thence east 336 feet to a point; thence south 209 feet to the place of beginning; except the rights of the public in and to so much thereof as is included in Olson Road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
