CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GARDINER LUMBER COMPANY
J. H. KENESSON, VICE PRESIDENT

of Gardiner, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring branch a tributary of Jimmy Creek, a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use and fire protection for lumber manufacturing plant, under Permit No. 17442 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 23, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.016 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 22 South, Range 9 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 13 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 18
T. 22 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
