CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT AND DOROTHY BAKER

of Route 1, Box 122, Monroe, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Oliver Creek a tributary of Marys River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 17615 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 18, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Heman C. Buckingham D.L.C. No. 53, Section 14, Township 14 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.2 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Heman C. Buckingham D.L.C. No. 53
1.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Heman C. Buckingham D.L.C. No. 53
Section 14
T. 14 S. R. 6 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows:

Tract 1: Beginning at a point 58 rods South of the Northwest corner of the Heman C. Buckingham Donation Land Claim, it being Notification 5106 in Township Fourteen South, Range Six West of the Willamette Meridian, running thence East 15 rods; thence South 25 rods and 14 feet and 6 inches, thence East 85 rods thence South 76 rods and 2 feet, thence West 100 rods, thence North 102 rods to the place of beginning. Excepting therefrom a certain right of way deeded to the C. & A Railway Co., November 11, 1909 and recorded in Book 53 page 426 Deed Records For Benton County, Oregon.

Tract 2: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Heman C. Buckingham Donation Land Claim, it being Notification 5106, in Township Fourteen South, Range Six West of the Willamette Meridian, thence East 100 rods, thence South 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods and 14 feet 6 inches, thence West 85 rods, thence North 25 rods, 14 feet and 6 inches, thence West 15 rods, thence North 58 rods to the place of beginning.

Except tract described as follows: Beginning at a point 58 rods South of the Northwest corner of Heman C. Buckingham Donation Land Claim, it being Notification 5106, in Township Fourteen South, Range Six West of the Willamette Meridian, running thence East 15 rods, thence South 25 rods, and 14 feet and 6 inches, thence West 15 rods, thence North 25 rods, 14 feet and 6 inches to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
