CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK RADA

of Mill City, , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of five unnamed springs

a tributary of North Santiam River
for the purpose of domestic use for nine families, including irrigation of not to exceed a cre domestic under Permit No. 18131
of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 8, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SWA NEA and NWA SEA, Section 30, Township 9 South, Range 3 East, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the NE corner of the SW_4^2 of the NE $_4^4$ of Sec. 30, T. 9 S., R. 3 E. of the W.M., Marion County, Oregon; thence S. 95 1/3 rods to the NE corner of land owned by Marion County at Vol. 217 page 123 deed records for Marion County; Oregon and being 1066 feet north and 1303 feet east of the SW corner of the NW $_4^2$ of the SE $_4^2$ of Section 30; thence west 1 $_4^4$ 0 feet; thence south 20 feet more or less to the NE corner of land owned by Swift at Vol. 196 page 127 Deed records for Marion County, Oregon (Now Owned by Spicer); thence westerly along the northerly line of said tract and parallel with the county road 205 feet; thence northwesterly still along the northerly line of said tract to a point 200 feet easterly and parallel with the county road from a point 1166 feet north and 400 feet east from the SW corner of the NW $_4^1$ of the SE $_4^1$ of Section 30; thence westerly still along the northerly line of said tract 200 feet to said last mentioned point; thence north 15 $_4$ feet to the center line running east and west thru section 30; thence east along said line 260 feet; thence north 80 rods, thence East 40 rods to the place of beginning and containing 15 acres of land more or less. Save and except land owned by Rada at Vol. 219 page 576 deed records for Marion County Oregon; and except all roads and roadways.

Property previously owned Frank Rada who are furnished water from Rada pipe line.

Beginning at a point which is 492 feet North and 940 feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of section 30 in Township 9 South of Range 3 east of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; thence East 140 feet; thence South 100 feet; thence Northwesterly 147 feet; thence North 64 feet to

the place of beginning.

Also: Beginning at the Southwest corner of a parcel of land deeded by J. S. Wadsworth to Carl Lofgren in the year of 1910, situated in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 30, Township 9 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; thence running South 54 feet, thence Easterly 52 feet; thence North 24 feet; thence West 49 feet to the place of Beginning. These two tracts are in one piece. One house.

Parcel #2

Beginning at a point on the North line of the old road which is North 630 feet and East 400 feet from the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of section 30 in Township 9 South of Range 3 East of the Will. Mer. Marion County, Oregon; thence running North 147.5 feet to the South line of Highway 222; thence S. 88° 20' E. 100 feet; thence South 160 feet to the North line of the old road; thence N. 81° 16' W. 100.8 feet to the point of beginning. One house.

Parcel #3 Owned by Frank Rada

Beginning at a point on the North line of the old road which is North 618 feet and East 500 feet from the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 30 in Township 9 South of Range 3 East of the Will. Mer., Marion County, Oregon; thence running North 160 feet to the South line of Highway 222; thence S. 88° 20' E. 300 feet along the South line of said highway to the West line of a North and South Street; thence South 213 feet to the North line of said old road; thence N. 81° 16' W. 200 feet to the point of beginning. Two houses.

Parcel #4 Frank Rada Home Tract

Beginning at a point onthe South line of Highway 222 which is North 745 feet and East 940 feet from the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of section 30 in Township 9 Scuth of Range 3 East of the Will. Mer. Marion County, Oregon; thence running S. 88° 20° E. 145 feet; thence South 226 feet to the North line of the old road; thence Northwesterly 145 feet; thence North 220 feet to the point of beginning. One house.

Parcel #5 Duplex House Tract

Beginning at a point which is 925 feet North and 940 feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of section 30 in Township 9 South of Range 3 East of the Will. Mer. Marion County, Oregon; thence running North 100 feet; thence S. 88° 20' E. 100 feet; thence South 100 feet; thence N. 88° 20' W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
