CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK AND ELVA PATTON

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well, tributary to East Branch of Mud Creek a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. U-77 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 19, 1934

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second, measured at the point of diversion,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
4.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 16
T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
