## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

## This Is to Certify, That REX LEE

Lee's Wilson River Camp

of Tillamook , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unmaxed creek

a tributary of Wilson River

for the purpose of

domestic use for recreation camp under Permit No. 15232 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 23, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_2^1$ , Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 7 West, W. I.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 10

T. 1 N., R. 7 W., W. E.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Commencing at the northwest corner of Section Ten, in Township one North Range seven West, Willamette Meridian, thence running in a southerly direction on said section line a distance of 785 feet, more or less to the center of the Wilson River Highway, thence running in an easterly direction in the center of said highway a distance of 643 feet, which point is the center of the Wilson River Highway, which point is the commencing point of the tract of land to be described; thence running in the center of the Wilson River Highway in an easterly direction 500 feet to a point in the center of said highway, thence running north 700 feet to a point; thence running in a westerly direction 1386 feet more or less to a point which is 145 feet, more or less North of the center of the Wilson River, being the Northwest corner of this tract of land; thence running in a southerly direction meandering along the center of the Wilson River 1271 feet more or less, to the place of beginning, containing ten (10) acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
