of Route 4, Box 795, Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Two Springs
a tributary of Porter Creek. a tributary of Ten Mile Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family and livestock
under Permit No. 16103 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 18, 1944;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 400 gallons per day, being 260 gallons per day from West Spring #1 and 140 gallons per day from East Spring #2,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 ($NE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$), Section 29, Township 28 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
