CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** B. K. JOURNEY AND FLORENCE JOURNEY

of Route 2, Springfield, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Holden Creek a tributary of McKenzie River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 10769 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1932

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second, measured at the point of diversion from the stream,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.2 acres in Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 17  
T. 17 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: The land in question is West  $\frac{1}{2}$  Lot 1, Sec. 17, Twp. 17 S. R. 1 E.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
