CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES C. COLEGROVE

of Junction City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Long Tom River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 13956 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 8, 1939;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Aaron Richardson D.L.C. No. 44, Section 10, Township 14 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.1 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Aaron Richardson D.L.C. No. 44
1.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Aaron Richardson D.L.C. No. 44
14.1 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Aaron Richardson D.L.C. No. 44
5.2 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Aaron Richardson D.L.C. No. 44
1.6 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Aaron Richardson D.L.C. No. 44

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the N. E. Corner of the Original Donation Land Claim of Wm. Barclay it being Not. #2530 in T. 14 S. R. 5 W Willamette Meridian Benton Co. thence West 13.89 chains, thence South 36 chains, thence E. 13.86 chains, thence N. 36 chains to place of beginning (50 A.). Beginning at N. E. Corner of Donation Claim of A. Richardson in T. 14 S. R. 5 W thence S. 10.50 chains to middle of Long Tom River, following stream 25.25 chains N. 24.40 chains to the North line of said claim E 20.25 chains to beginning (35 A.). Beginning at S. E. Corner of W. Barclay's D. L. C. #43 in T. 14 S of Range 5 W. thence W. 13.71 chains to A. Richardson N. E. Corner, thence S. 10.50 chains to the center of Long Tom River, thence N. 58 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. along center of Long Tom 16.00 chains thence North 2.80 Chains to Place of Beginning (8.56 A.). Also Beginning at a 3/4" pipe 20.25 chains S. 89° 46' W. along Claim line from the N. E. Corner of A. Richardson D. L. C. #44, T. 14 S. R. 5 W. thence S. 25 Chains to Center line of Long Tom, thence along line center of said stream S. 68° 31' W. 8.12 Chains to a point 2.193 Chains S. of 1" pipe thence N. 27.953 Chains to 1" Iron Rod on N. line of said Claim thence N. 89° 46' E. 7.556 to place of beginning (20 A.).

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
