of Route 1, Box 19a, Dundee , State of Oregon. , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of not to exceed \(\frac{1}{2} \) acre domestic lawer Formit No. 17644 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Earch 28, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE¹/₂ SE¹/₂, as projected on Andrew Harvey D.L.C. No. 58. Section 23, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW¹₄ SW¹₄, as projected on Andrew Harvey D.L.C. No. 58 Section 24 T. 3 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Lot 33 in Hobsons fruitland subdivision Yamhill County State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
