## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

## This Is to Certify, That MARVIN J. AND CONSTANCE N. ROBB

of Route 4, Box 274, Hillsboro , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bronson Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 11:917 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in at graance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 23, 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_4^1$ , as projected on Wm. H. Bennett D.L.C. No. 47, Section 35, Township 1 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to pne-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

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conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre in the NW1 NW1, as projected on Wm. H. Bennett D.L.C. No. 40
Section 2
0.4 acre in the NE1 NE1, as projected on Wm. H. Bennett D.L.C. No. 40
Section 3
T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
