CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLEY E. WALKMAN
of Route 1, Box 181, Tillamook, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Nestucca River
a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation
under Permit No. 15931 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from August 1, 1914

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.38 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 4 South, Range 10
West, W. 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

8.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
22.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 14
T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly de-
scribed by the appropriator as follows: The East half of the Southwest Quarter
of that part of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter lying on the South-
east side of the Big Nestucca River, and that part of the Northwest quarter of the
Southwest quarter lying on the Southeast side of the Big Nestucca River being in
Section 14, Township 4 South of Range 10 West of the Willamette Meridian. Save and
except one half acre heretofore deeded to Joseph Wilson by deed recorded in Book #3
page 86 deed records of Tillamook County Oregon; and save and except 20 acres of
said described land deeded to Belle Wilson Nov. 11, 1907 of the South side of the
said land.

Save and except from the above described land the following tract of land
to-wit: Located in Section 14, Township 4 South of Range 10 West of Willamette
Meridian. Starting from the Northeast corner of the Belle Wilson 20 acre tract of
land and running thence north 1 degree and 13' West 1079.9 ft. thence north 6 degrees
8' West 118 Ft. thence north 17 degrees 53' West 91.4 ft. thence South 82 degrees
4' West 1852.8 ft. to the present center line of the Big Nestucca River, thence
along said center line south 37 degrees 18' East 327.2 ft. thence south 33 degrees
23' East 291.2 ft. thence South 29 degrees 48' East 302.2 ft. thence South 17° 5'
West 288.6 ft. to the North line of said Belle Wilson 20 acre tract thence South
89 degrees 21' East 14-78.1 ft. to place of beginning Containing 43.07 acres more
or less including 1.87 acres of river, and 0.83 acres of County road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
