of McMinnville State of , has made proof Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of four unnamed springs and unnamed creek, tributary of Panther Creek a tributary of North Fork Yamhill River 1rrigation, domestic use for one family and stock, under Permit No.10300 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters

has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 20, 1931

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from each spring and 0.085 cubic foot per second from creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 4 SE 4, Section 36, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, W. M. (diversion from unnamed creek for irrigation); point of diversion from Spring No. 1 for domestic use is located in SE4 NW4, Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
