CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LEON M. BERNSTEIN

of McMinnville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of four unnamed springs and unnamed creek, tributary of Panther Creek a tributary of North Fork Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation, domestic use for one family and stock, under Permit No. 10300 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 20, 1931

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from each spring and 0.085 cubic foot per second from creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 36, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, W. M. (diversion from unnamed creek for irrigation); point of diversion from Spring No. 1 for domestic use is located in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

that certain water Right Certificates.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.8 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36 T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Stock in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 6 T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Domestic and stock in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Stock in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Stock in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1 T. 4 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The point of diversion from unnamed creek for irrigation use, and the location of springs for domestic and stock use are more particularly described by the appropriator as follows:

Diversion from creek: The point of diversion is 300 ft. N from S 1/4 corner of Sec. 36, T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Spring #1: is N 70° 30' E. 2070' from West 1/4 cor. of Sec. 1, T. 4 S., R. 5 W.

Spring #2: is N 40° W 1680' from S. E. Cor. Sec. 1, T. 4 S., R. 5 W.

Spring #3: is N 34° W 1610' from S. E. Cor. Sec. 1, T. 4 S., R. 5 W.

Spring #4: is N 28° 30' W 1690' from South 1/4 Cor. of Sec. 6, T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W. M., being within SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 36, Tp. 3 S. R. 5 W, W.M. in Yamhill County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
