CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That

T. L. SHEROD

of Rt. 2, Freewater State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Dugger Greek, a tributary of Pine Greek,

for the purpose of supplementing the water supply for the irrigation of forty acres of land; also stock and domestic use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State William of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 321; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 19, 1911 for 29.8 acres and from 1900 for 10.2 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow from all sources of supply of 0.50 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year or its equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 120 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

40 acres in Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty (30), Township Six (6) North Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

Attention is called to Certificate of Water Right recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 2, at page 908, covering the irrigation of the above tract with the waters of a swamp.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
