CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY E. ALTMAN

of Route #1, Box 695, Oswego, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Spring Creek a tributary of Tyron Creek for the purpose of Irrigation and Ponds under Permit No. 14868 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 16, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.0125 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.0175 cubic foot per second for ponds,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to $\frac{1}{80}$ th of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1 acre and pond in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 33
T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Tract 15, ALDERCREST, also that part of Tract 14, of said ALDERCREST described as follows: Beginning at a point in the East line of said Tract 14, at the intersection with the North boundary of a dedicated road on the South line of said tract; running thence North 14° 11' East, on the said East boundary of said Tract 14, 120.90 feet to an iron pipe driven in the ground for a corner; thence South 69° 26' West, 215.09 feet to an iron pipe driven for a corner in the North boundary of said dedicated road; thence South 76° 22' East, 176.74 feet to the place of beginning, in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
