CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Marvin L. Kinzey

of Wamic

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Three Mile Creek, a tributary of White River,

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1898;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 24 of said decree);

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

6 acres in NEL NEL - 575
0.75 * 6.5 acres in NWL NEL - 575
Section 18,
T. 4 S., R. 12 E., W. M.

Note: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 21, 1948, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Abraham T. Shaley and recorded at page 5766, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
