CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That G. R. Moore

of Lake Creek, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of South Fork of Little Butte Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation and power

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 17202 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February, 1894; 498

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second; measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year, for irrigation and 1.0 cubic foot per second for the development of power.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of use for Irrigation

10 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 9 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 18, T. 37 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

Place of use for Power

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 18, T. 37 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

Power claim #322

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
