CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That John Walsh

of Lake Creek, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of South Fork of Little Butte Creek and Lost Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation for Tract No. 1 from South Fork of Little Butte Creek and Irrigation, domestic and stock for Tract No. 2 from Lost Creek and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885 for Tract No. 1 and 1887 for Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.65 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 1 and 0.38 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2; measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1

22.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
12.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3,
T. 37 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

Tract No. 2

12.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
5.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4,
T. 37 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
