CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. E. ALEXANDER

of Route 1 - Box 158, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Carpenter Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16644 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 18, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Wm. R. Carpenter D.L.C. No. 39, Section 2, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Wm. Beagle D.L.C. No. 38
- 0.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Wm. Beagle D.L.C. No. 38
- 7.3 acres in Lot 6 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 1.5 acres in Lot 7 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 2

Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Being part of the DIC No. 38 & 39 in T.1 S., R.4 W. of the W.M. and all of Lot 3 of Sec. 3; to wit: Beginning at the N.E. corner of the Wm. Carpenter DIC No. 39 said Township and Range, running thence N. 24° 16' W. 17.64 chs; thence S. 65° 14' W. 6.30 chs; thence S. 35° 40' E. 1.12 chs; thence S. 86° 50' W. 55.77 chs. to the NW corner of the Carpenter claim; thence N. 2° 10' W. 10.93 chs; thence S. 89° W. 12.70 chs. to the W. line of the Wm. Beagle C1; thence S. 2° 10' E. 13.01 chs; thence E. 12.70 chs. to the W. line of the Carpenter Claim; thence S. 0° 39' E. 11.40 chs; thence N. 87° E. to the center of Alexander Creek, and following the center of same down stream a total of 67.96 chs; thence N. 1° 7' E. 00.10 chs. to the place of beginning & containing 104.66 acres more or less. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is to correct and supersede that certain water right certificate issued by the State Engineer on Feb. 28, 1950, to J. E. Alexander, which certificate is recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 14, page 17054, so as to correctly describe the source of supply as Carpenter Creek instead of an unnamed stream, tributary of Carpenter Creek.
