## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** Steven L. Steidl

of Box 1009, Bend, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Deschutes River  
for the purpose of development of power

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 362; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from September 15, 1906;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 50 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

## NOTE:

The decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, entered February 10, 1928, in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of water from Deschutes River and its tributaries, allowed Steidl and Tweet a right to the use of 250 cubic feet per second of water from Deschutes River for power development.

On December 15, 1936, Steven L. Steidl, successor to Steidl and Tweet, filed Annual Statement of Water Power Claimant, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 47-1701 and 47-1702, Oregon Code 1930, wherein the quantity of water claimed was reduced from 250 cubic feet per second to 50 cubic feet per second and paid annual license fees based on the use of 50 cubic feet per second, each and every year thereafter. This certificate therefore, limits the maximum quantity of water to be used for power development to 50 cubic feet per second.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
