CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That George Yokom

of Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Birch Creek and Dry Creek a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 13286 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 14, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.68 cubic foot per second, being 2.84 c.f.s. from Birch Creek and 1.84 c.f.s. from Dry Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15 and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, from Birch Creek and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 12 South, Range 29 East, from Dry Creek

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, for each acre irrigated prior to June 1st and thereafter 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month prior to June 1st and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to September 30th of each year, and shall be limited still further to a total diversion of not to exceed 4.68 c.f.s., being 2.84 c.f.s. from Birch Creek and 1.84 c.f.s. from Dry Creek and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
