CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. H. and Maxine Nagaman

, State of Oregon , has made proof of Route 1, Box 359, Newberg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Chehalem Creek, tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 15516 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been per ected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 18, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE' SE' and NN SE'. Section 14, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other of one cubic foot per second right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.7 acres in NE 1_4 SE 1_4 , as projected on the Matthew Hall D. L. C. 72 0.5 acre in NW 1_4 SE 1_4 , as projected on the Matthew Hall D. L. C. 72 Section 14 T. 3 S., R. 3 W., W. H.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Situate, lying and being in the County of Yamhill and State of Oregon, and being a part of the North half of the original Donation Land Claim of Malinda Hall, and the heirs at law of Matthew Hall, deceased, Claim numbered 72, Notification numbered 1775, parts of Sections 13, 14-23 and 24 in Township 3 South, Range 3 West, of the Willamette Meridian in the aforesaid County and State said part being bounded and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West boundary line of said claim thrity-two and 5957.1000 chains North of the Southeast corner of the original Donation Land Claim of John Williamson and Susan O. Williamson, his wife, claim numbered 46 in the said County, State, Township and Range, said beginning point being also the Northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed by the Grantors herein to T. S. Sutton and wife, on the 28th day of July A. D. 1919 by Deed which is recorded at page 125 in Volume 78 of the Record of Deeds in and for said County and State, and running thence Easterly following the North line of said Sutton tract 11 chains to the Northeast corner of said tract, thence Northeparallel with the West line of said Hall claim 4.546 chains, thence Westerly parallel with South line of premises hereby conveyed 11 chains to West boundary line of said Hall claim, and thence Southerly following said West line of said Hall claim, 4.546 chains to place of beginning, and containing 5 acres of land, more or less.
