CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That *Mrs. Marie M. Putman,
Henry Gant and Ken Mickalson*
Route 1, Box 46, Otis
of Rose Lodge, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed stream
a tributary of Salmon River for the purpose of
domestic use for three families, including the irrigation of gardens not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ acre
under Permit No. 15474 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 23, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 6 South, Range 10
West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 35
T. 6 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described
by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly margin of the Salmon River Cut-off
Highway No. 18 said point being more particularly described as North 34 15' East,
one-hundred thirty-six (136) distant from the intersection of the line between the
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 6 South, Range 10
West, W. M. in Lincoln County with the easterly margin of the above mentioned
highway No. 18;

Thence North 34 15' East, four-hundred eighty-three (483) feet along
margin of Highway No. 18, to a point marked by iron pipe in ground;

Thence South 54, 45' East, eight-hundred ninety-one (891) feet to inter-
section of the above described line and marked by iron pipe in ground;

Thence North 89 52' West eight-hundred thirty-nine (839) feet along said
line to a corner of Jacksons parcel of land;

Thence North 54 45' West one-hundred ninety-seven (197) feet along the
Northerly boundary line of the said Jackson land to place of beginning;
containing 6.3/25 acres, more or less. (Description of Louis N. Wise property)

Beginning at a point in the westerly margin of the "Salmon River Cut-off"
Highway No. 18, said point being S 35° 15', W seven-hundred and thirty-one feet
distant from the intersections of the section line between sections twenty-six and
thirty-five, Township Six South, Range Ten West, Willamette Meridian, with Highway
No. 18.

Thence N 54° 45', W. 125 feet to middle of Salmon River. Thence S 39° 13',

W 168.25 feet to a point in river.

Thence S 54° 45', E 136 feet to westerly margin of Highway No. 18. Thence N 35° 15', E 167 feet along margin of Highway to place of beginning, containing one-half acre more or less and said starting point is more particularly located where the center of the highway crosses the section line between Sec. 26 and 35 in said township and range.
(Description of Ken Mickalson property)

Beginning at a point in the westerly margin of the Salmon River Cut-Off Highway No. 18, said point being South 35° 15', West 958 feet from the intersection of the section line between sections twenty six and thirty five, Township Six South, Range Ten West of the Willamette Meridian, with Highway No. 18.

Thence North 54° 45' West 128 feet to a point in the middle of the Salmon River;

Thence South 25° 15' West, 334.4 feet to a point in Salmon River;

Thence South 54° 45' East 63 feet to westerly margin of Highway No. 18;

Thence North 35° 15' East 328 feet along margin of Highway to place of beginning, containing 87/121 of an acre, in Lincoln County.

(Description of Henry Gant property)

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
