CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That North Douglas Mills, Inc.

of Sutherlin, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Camas Swale and log pond constructed under Permit No. R-805 a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of log pond and manufacturing under Permit No. 16109 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 25, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.90 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

log pond and mill in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Log pond in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20
T. 25 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Lots 10 & 11, Flat "C", Southerlin Land & Water Company

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
