## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That Lawrence P. and Pauline Thornton

of Kerby , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of Illinois River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 16451 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 27, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SET NWT, Section 27, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Description:

The South Half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Lot 2, in Section 16, Township 39 South Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
